
Value creation network FRISC 2011-2015





# Distribution of 34 active COINS students by consortium members




# Number of COINS students by research area

#### Research School of Computer and Information Security

In light of a worrying increase in serious Information Security breaches in Norway and internationally, the Research Council announced the establishment of a national research school of Information Security. The Research School "COINS Research School of Computer and Information Security" will be led by Gjøvik University College. Participants in the research school include NTNU, University of Oslo, University of Bergen, University of Agder, University of Stavanger, and University of Tromsø.


